Project Description	 The Emergency Examination Authority is a legal instrument used by the Govt of Queensland under an amendment to the public health act 2016. The change in legislation authorizes a first responder attending to an episode of violent mental health episode to apprehend and admit an individual to an emergency department (ED) of a Health Service. The ED can keep the individual for up to 24 hours before releasing them in society. In a series of recent publications, we have shown that this legislation is quite unhelpful in addressing several issues in the Far North Queensland – a. Repeat admissions indicate that we are failing in our duty of care. b. The involved first responders – police service, ambulance service, and emergency department(s) often lack the capacity – expertise and time-processary in addressing the underlying clinical
	necessary in addressing the underlying clinical condition. This current project would extend this investigation across the state of Queensland, the second largest Australian state by area. The spatial variation of our findings would have
	significant social consequence for all end-users including patients, carers, and first responders.
